

RESURRECTION

1 Cor 15:20 But now Messiah has been raised from the dead, and has become the first-fruit of those having fallen asleep.

Ps 16:8-10 I have set Yahweh always before me; because He is at my right hand I am not shaken. Therefore my heart was glad, and my esteem rejoices; my flesh also dwells in safety. For You do not leave my being in She'ol, neither let your favoured one see corruption.

Ps 17:15 As for me, let Me see Your face in righteousness; I am satisfied to see Your appearance when I awake.

Ps 49:15 But Elohim does redeem my being from the power of She'ol, for He does receive me.

Isa 25:8 He shall swallow up death forever, and the Master Yahweh shall wipe away tears from all faces, and take away the reproach of His people from all the earth. For Yahweh has spoken.

Ezek 37:14 And I shall put My Spirit in you, and you shall live, and I shall settle you in your own land. And you shall know that I Yahweh have spoken, and I have done it, declares Yahweh.

Dan 12:2 (There shall be a time when) many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall wake up, some to everlasting life, and some to reproaches, everlasting abhorrence.

Dan 12:13 Go your way till the end. And rest, and arise to your lot at the end of the days.

Hos 13:14 "From the power of She'ol I ransom them, from death I redeem them. Where is your plague, O Death? Where is your destruction, O She'ol?

Mat 22:31-32 "And concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by Elohim, saying, 'I am the Elohim of Avraham, and the Elohim of Yitschaq, and the Elohim of Ya'aqov'? Elohim is not the Elohim of the dead, but of the living."

Mat 24:31 And He shall send His messengers with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His chosen ones from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

Joh 5:28-29 The hour is coming in which all those in the tombs shall hear His voice, and shall come forth – those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have practised evil matters, to a resurrection of judgment.

Act 24:14-15 I worship the Elohim of my fathers, believing all that has been written in the Torah and in the Prophets, having an expectation in Elohim ... that there is to be a resurrection of the dead, both of the righteous and the unrighteous.

Rom 8:11 And if the Spirit of Him who raised Y'shua from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Messiah ... shall also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit dwelling in you.

1 Cor 6:14 And Elohim, who raised up the Master, shall also raise us up through His power.

2 Cor 4:14 He who raised up the Master Y'shua shall also raise us up through Y'shua.

Col 1:18 And He is the Head of the body, the assembly, who is the beginning, the first-born from the dead, that He might become the One who is first in all.

1 Thes 4:14 For if we believe that Y'shua died and rose again, so also Elohim shall bring with Him those who sleep in Y'shua.

1 Thes 4:16 The Master Himself shall come down from heaven with a shout, with the voice of a chief messenger, and with the trumpet of Elohim, and the dead in Messiah shall rise first.

Rev 20:6 Blessed and set-apart is the one having part in the first resurrection. The second death possesses no authority over these, but they shall be priests of Elohim and of Messiah, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.
