🕯 Ps 15:1-2 Who may dwell in your set-apart mountain? He who speaks the truth in his heart. Eph 4:25 Speak truth, each one with his neighbour, for we are members of one another.

🕯 **First in the heart, then on the outside.**

- Is it possible to be honest with others while still being dishonest with yourself?

🕯 Ps 41:1 Blessed is he who considers the poor, Yahweh shall deliver him. Gal 2:10 We went to the nations, remembering the poor.

🕯 **Belief needs to be grounded in care.**

- Do the two words, consider and remember, mean wait and react to situations, or take deliberate action?

🕯 Ps 34:13 Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit. 1 Pet 3:10 He who wishes to see good days, let him keep his tongue from evil, and his lips from speaking deceit

🕯 **Control in speech affects quality of living.**

🕯 Ps 34:14 Turn away from evil and do good; seek peace, and pursue it. Rom 12:18 If possible, on your part, be at peace with all men.

🕯 Ps 62:10 If riches increase, Do not set your heart on them. 1 Tim 6:17 Do not trust in the uncertainty of riches, but in the living Elohim, who gives us richly.

🕯 **Trust in riches damages trust in Yahweh**

- How can we check to ensure that money remains a tool rather than a master?

🕊 Ps 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O Elohim, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Mat 5:8 Blessed are the clean in heart because they shall see Elohim.

🕊 Purity and walking before Him, goes hand in hand

- If purity is a creation miracle of Yahweh, what is OUR role?



🕊 Ps 32:1 Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven. Eph 4:32 Be kind towards one another...forgiving one another, as Elohim also forgave you in Messiah.

🕊 Having tasted the joy of being forgiven, we should forgive others

- Why do we struggle to forgive others, while our forgiveness changed our lives?



🕊 Ps 68:5 Father of the fatherless, and Right-ruler of widows, Is Elohim. Jam 1:27 Clean devotion before Elohim is this: visit orphans and widows in their affliction.

🕊 Yahweh is their Protector and we should mirror this passion of our Father

- Can we say that we truly know Yahweh if we do not mirror His protective nature?



🕊 Ps 37:8 Abstain from displeasure, and forsake wrath. Eph 4:31 Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you.

🕊 We are told in Proverbs that he that is slow to anger, is better than the mighty

- What is the difference between hiding anger and dealing with anger?



🕊 Ps 103:2 Bless Yahweh O my being, and do not forget all His benefits! 1 Thes 5:18 Give thanks in all circumstances for this is the desire of Elohim in Messiah.

🕊 Having received unlimited blessings from Him, thanksgiving is always in order!

- How does a heart of gratitude change how we bring our needs before Yahweh?
