reap on blessing


What it DOES Teach: HEAR AND OBEY!

Charis (Gr) → Chen (He) → To bend in kindness




"If you diligently obey the voice of Yahweh your Elohim ... guard all His commands ... Yahweh shall set you high above all nations of the earth" Deut 28:1

"Diligently obey" ... Shamoah Tishma ... hearing you will hear!



The importance of the "if" (Heb: "im")

Precious Vessel

I need to be a "kli yakar" (precious vessel) so that I may be able to receive and hold Yahweh's blessings.

"Whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak"


"I do not speak on my own authority"
